



Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (Do Not Drink Notice)

This Advisory applies to all residents and users of the Town of Fleming's Water distribution system and is effective immediately, August 25, 2020.

This Do Not Drink Notice is issued due to the exceedances of drinking water quality standards of manganese and disinfection byproducts and does not meet the required minimum ozone residual.

Due to the challenging raw water source quality, the Town of Fleming's Water Treatment system cannot effectively and safely treat the distributed water to meet the Saskatchewan Drinking Water Quality Standards and therefore, the Water Security Agency and Town of Fleming are advising all consumers to NOT USE THE TAP WATER FOR DRINKING AND COOKING UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

Consumers should do the following:

Do Not Drink Your Tap Water – Use Only Bottled Water. Bottled water or other source of known good quality water should be used for all drinking (including baby formula and juice), brushing teeth, washing dishes, making ice and food preparation.

Do Not Try and Treat The Water Yourself. Boiling, freezing, filtering, adding chlorine or other disinfectants, or letting the water stand will not make the water safe.

This Advisory is effective immediately as listed above, and will not be lifted until the water supply is determined to be completely safe.
