**PRECAUTIONARY DRINKING WATER ADVISORY
(Do Not Drink Notice)**

This Notice applies to all residents and users of the Village of Kannata Valley's Waterworks

and is effective: Monday, October 30, 2000.

This Do Not Drink Notice is issued due to the levels of arsenic in the water being higher than Saskatchewan Environment's limits.

Testing has shown arsenic levels above Saskatchewan Environment limits in the drinking water supplied by the Village of Kannata Valley's waterworks due to naturally occurring arsenic in the groundwater. Saskatchewan Environment and the Village of Kannata Valley are advising all consumers to **NOT USE THE TAP WATER FOR DRINKING AND COOKING UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.**

Consumers should do the following:

- **Do Not Drink Your Tap Water – Use Only Bottled Water.** Bottled water or other source of known good quality water should be used for all drinking (including baby formula and juice), brushing teeth, washing dishes, making ice and food preparation.
- **Do Not Try and Treat The Water Yourself.** Boiling, freezing, filtering, adding chlorine or other disinfectants, or letting the water stand will not make the water safe.

You will be informed once improvements have been made to the water system and tests indicate the water is safe for consumption.
